From all of us here at Lighthouse Educational Ministries, I just want to take a moment and express my appreciation for all of your encouragement and financial support throughout the years.

Not only have we been doing prison ministry for almost 20 years but we were able, by the grace of God, to have the opportunity to open 4 transitional homes a few years ago and help hundreds have a place to rest their heads and begin the journey of transition. Only by God's grace and your prayers could we have done that and have come this far and have accomplished so much. To God be the glory!!!!! AMEN......

I am sad to say that due to lack of funding, those homes were closed down officially in December 2011. I gave my heart and soul, not to mention tens of thousands of dollars to open and keep them going - even to the point of losing my own home along with all those other homes when I could not afford to keep doing it. "Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for my sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions—and in the age to come, eternal life." I have been asked for the last several years why I did what I did and do what I do. It seems that God has a special love and concern for the salvation of those who need Him the most. Criminal behavior is not very lovable. Therefore, it takes a special kind of love to have compassion on those who have caused so much suffering. God's Word is very clear when He tells us to visit the prisoners in Hebrews 13:3 NKJV. "Remember the prisoners, as if chained with them, and those who are mistreated, since you yourselves are in the body also."

We see ourselves as mere links in God's Holy chain. For it has been our experience that the Lord uses various people from different walks of life, to achieve His objectives. **See my testimony on our improved website.**

We believe that Jesus made it clear when told us in the Scripture "for I was hungry and you gave me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me."

All of our literature is distributed to prisoners for free. We are a faith-based ministry and believe that the less fortunate deserve a second chance. Just like the rest of us. Amen....

Entrusted with the Gospel

Imagine standing by a pool, watching your children get ready to swim. The youngest asks you to hold something—a dirty plastic pail. The oldest makes a similar request and then hands you an heirloom opal necklace that had been her grandmother's. Most likely, you wouldn't worry too much about protecting the toy, but you would guard the jewelry with great care. The way we handle a possession reveals the value we attach to it.

We see this principle in Jesus' parable about the master who before going away, entrusted his workers with various sums of money. The two who invested theirs were later commended for wise use of the funds. Their efforts showed that they valued both the treasure and their master. A third worker, however, simply buried his portion in the ground and all he "earned" was a harsh rebuke and loss of what little treasure he had.

Like these men, we are responsible for something of great worth—far greater, in fact, than money. God has placed in our keeping the most powerful and precious message in existence, the gospel of Jesus Christ. And we are accountable for what we do with it. Our "investment" involves both how we apply its truth to our own life and whether we share it with others.

Ministry Prayer Needs

- Prayer is needed for our new opportunity in the Maui Community Correctional Center. Chaplain has asked Pastor Ron to come and give 4 services a month to the inmates.
 - We need volunteers on Maui to help Pastor Ron.
- Pray for Pastor Ron Zaucha, who directs this Prison Ministry, Educates his Teams and Educates the Prisoners
 - Pray for Ron's Health and that he would have complete healing over his entire body, especially his Heart (Working at 40% capacity).
